OXYGEN FOR INDIA: India recently set a new world record of 400,000 new Covid cases per day for three consecutive weeks. Rob Nash, Cooperative Baptist Fellowship Global Missions Coordinator and President of Asian Indian Ministries, Inc. (AIM), reports that "people are dying while waiting in long lines at hospitals." Others are being turned away and sent home to die there.

At Memorial Baptist Church we learned recently that Joseph Das' cousin's wife's grandmother died because she couldn't get any oxygen. She had the money to buy a tank, but there were none to be had. Our gifts may help someone else escape that same fate.

Sam Bandela served as a CBF field representative with Indian immigrants in Atlanta from 1994-2000, and then overseas in India until he retired in 2017. In retirement Sam works with AIM, and one of his most pressing tasks these days is finding and purchasing oxygen tanks for delivery to India to be used by Covid-19 patients. Westwood Baptist Church, a CBF congregation close-by in Cary, is already in partnership with Sam to help provide the air the people need. WE CAN HELP, TOO!

\$650 donated to AIM will purchase one oxygen tank. That may not sound like much, but it just might save a life. If you want to help, make your donation to Memorial Baptist Church through the usual channels and write "Oxygen" on the "FOR" line. We'll get it to Sam Bandela at Asian Indian Ministries and he will make it count.
