The team will:

- * rotate watch duties in the narthex & halls during services;
- * on Sunday morning, lock external doors to the building 15 minutes after the worship service begins;
- * alert church members and/or call law enforcement as necessary; but
- * WILL NOT provide active physical intervention; and
- * will report to the deacons evaluating on-going security needs.

As the team's duties are to observe and report but not intervene, any adult is invited to help. If you're interested, please contact Ashley in the church office and she will pass your name to the deacons.
